Established in 2020, Netball France is the governing body of Netball in France. With an estimated 300-400 players across the country, the sport has seen rapid growth in France since Netball France's inauguration with the launch of a number of events and programs. To continue this growth, and in line with the objectives of the Netball France Strategic Plan 2022-2025, Netball France is launching our inaugural national squads.

Netball France is ambitious in all areas, including our performance programs. Short term, our 2023 goal is for the Open National Squad to achieve a medal placing at the Europe Netball Open Challenge 2023 (May 11-14), and for our U21s National Squad to have a positive experience in their high performance training environment and at competition in the Europe Netball U21s Challenge 2023 (October 6-9). This leads into our long term strategic goals of our Open Squad receiving a top 20 World Ranking by 2025, and our U21s squad competing at the NWYC2025.

As such, we are looking for a number of passionate, driven, and ambitious people to join our high performance coaching and management staff to support the programs and their ambitions, aligned with the Netball France values. The roles available are: National Assistant Coach, U21s Head Coach, U21s Assistant Coach, National Team Manager, and U21s Team Manager. Please see below for role details and how to apply.

NATIONAL ASSISTANT COACH

The National Assistant Coach will report to the National Program Lead Coach (the Head Coach of the Open National Squad) and will be responsible in aiding them in their duties, including selecting and training the Open National Squad, in alignment with the values and objectives of Netball France.

The format and structure of the program is currently quite open as Netball France looks to build a high performance program with the input of the coaching staff. For the Open Squad, it will likely consist of training camps every 1-2 months, weekly at home ball/shooting/S&C programs for the athletes, and match play opportunities. The National Assistant Coach is expected to assist the National Program Lead Coach in all these areas. The Open Squad will be training with the goal of medalling in the Europe Netball Open Challenge Competition, to be held 11-14 May 2023 in Gibraltar.

U21S HEAD COACH

The U21s Head Coach will report to the National Program Lead Coach (the Head Coach of the Open National Squad) and will be responsible for selecting and training the U21s National Squad, under the direction of the National Program Lead Coach and aligned with the values and objectives of Netball France.

The format and structure of the program is currently quite open as Netball France looks to build a high performance program with the input of the coaching staff. For the U21s Squad, it will likely consist of weekend training camps every 2–3 months, weekly at home ball/shooting/S&C programs for the athletes, and match play opportunities. The U21s Head Coach is expected to lead in all these areas, under the direction of the National Program Lead Coach and with the









support of the U21s Assistant Coach. The U21s Squad will be training with the goal of competing in the Europe Netball U21s Challenge competition, to be held 6-9 October 2023 in England.

U21S ASSISTANT COACH

The U21s Assistant Coach will report to the U21s Head Coach and the National Program Lead Coach (the Head Coach of the Open Squad), and will be responsible in aiding the U21s Head Coach in their duties, including selecting and training the U21s National Squad, in alignment with the values and objectives of Netball France.

The format and structure of the program is currently quite open as Netball France looks to build a high performance program with the input of the coaching staff. For the U21s Squad, it will likely consist of weekend training camps every 2-3 months, weekly at home ball/shooting/S&C programs for the athletes, and match play opportunities. The U21s Head Coach is expected to lead in all these areas, under the direction of the National Program Lead Coach and with the support of the U21s Assistant Coach. The U21s Squad will be training with the goal of competing in the Europe Netball U21s Challenge competition, to be held 6-9 October 2023 in England.

NATIONAL TEAM MANAGER AND U21S TEAM MANAGER

The National Team Manager will report to the National Program Lead Coach and the Netball France Board. The U21s Team Manager will report to the U21s Head Coach and the Netball France Board.

Team managers will be responsible for all logistical and administration duties in regards to the relevant squad, liaising with the National Program Lead Coach and/or U21s Head Coach.

key duties

- Liaise with National Program Lead Coach and/or U21s Head Coach in regards to squad selections for match days/competition, squad travel arrangements, competition/event planning and kit
- © Coordinating training camps, including equipment, facilities, and other logistics
- Inform coaches and players the details of all training sessions and competitions in advance, including directions, maps, and other operational requirements
- Be pro-active to arrange umpires for training matches where necessary, liasing with the National Program Lead Coach and/or U21s Head Coach and the Officiating Work Group
- Liaise with the appropriate Event Coordinator for all competitions both home and away
- © Carry out squad management duties on match/competition days
- To provide appropriate supplies at matches and training and ensure players have all that they need
- To manage the kit requirements of the team and ensure distribution, recording of kit given, and return of all kit and equipment when required to do so
- © Ensure match results are submitted appropriately to Netball France Communications Team
- Maintain up to date record of players' personal details, notifying Netball France of any changes specifically to contact details
- Support the players through any requirements of Anti-Doping checks and Drug Testing
- Check and counter sign any expense claims from players, coaches, or officials, and maintain a record of all squad purchases and expenses, claiming for these where appropriate
