junior national squad assistant coach role

Established in 2020, Netball France is the governing body of Netball in France. With an estimated 400-500 players across the country, the sport has seen rapid growth in France since Netball France's inauguration with the launch of a number of events and programs. The first season of our Junior National Squad was highly successful, with 26 athletes participating in the inaugural squad. Netball France is looking to build on this success in the 2024/2025 season as our Junior National Squad works towards international competition opportunities. The Netball France Junior National Squad is mixed gender. Our Junior National Squad is mixed age and contains athletes from both U17 and U21 age groups (the age of current athletes ranges from 13-20).

PROGRAM STRUCTURE OVERVIEW

JUNIOR NATIONAL SQUAD ASSISTANT COACH

The Junior National Squad Assistant Coach will report to the Junior National Squad Head Coach & Performance Director and will be responsible for supporting the Junior National Squad Head Coach in training the Junior National Squad, collaborating with the Open National Squad coaches and staff to develop the French way of play, aligned with the values and objectives of Netball France.

The Junior National Squad will be training with the goal of competing in the Europe Netball U17 Event, Europe Netball U19 Training Matchplay Event, and a Netball France Hosted U21 Event in the 2024/2025 season.

key duties

- Support the Head Coach in coordinating the season schedule (camps & competitions) in conjunction with the Performance Director



- Development of individual athletes within the National Squad Program training environment
- Collaborate with fellow coaching staff and athletes to ensure processes and modifications are in place for athletes relating to training schedules, loading, injuries and rehabilitation, and well-being
- Support the Head Coach to plan and deliver training camps
- Support the Head Coach on venue booking and coordinating equipment at venues (marking lines, posts, first aid, etc.)
- Support the Head Coach on coordinating hosting and transport for travelling athletes (i.e. coordinating transport options for athletes who may be able to travel with you, coordinating hosting with local athletes/local club to reduce costs, including communication with local athletes/club, matching of hosts/hostees, etc.)
- Support the Head Coach to devise and implement Game Plan and strategies effectively for a variety of situations and opponents
- Within the squad develop required skills to deliver Game Plan and strategies successfully
- Liaise with the Performance Director and Open National Squad Coaching & Management Team in relation to national strategy, plans, and integration between the squads
 - This includes alignment with the Senior program (where feasible/appropriate) in areas such as warmups & cool downs, camp structure, feedback processes, selection processes, etc.
- Input towards High Performance, Operational plans and budgets and contribute to reports as requested
- Support the Head Coach to organise a NF Hosted U21 Event, in conjunction with the Performance Director & NF Board, including opposition, venue, umpires, equipment, accommodation, transport, first aid, etc.

skills & knowledge

Leadership

- Build a winning performance culture
- Use leadership to foster relationships, with athlete well-being at the forefront of all decisions
- Ability to communicate and transfer netball specific knowledge and skills to athletes
- Provide timely and effective feedback on performance

Interpersonal Skills

- Strong people & relationship skills with ability to adapt style with situational demands
- Establish and maintain professional working relationships with coaches and umpires
- Build trust and respect
- Use a variety of approaches to athlete learning and build confidence

Personal Attributes

- Reinforce and champion high performance outcomes
- Model the purpose and principles of the high-performance program
- Demonstrate personal credibility, honesty, integrity
- Is positive, confident, and decisive under pressure with the ability to make objective and quick decisions

essential criteria

- Experience with Netball coaching, ideally in a high-performance environment
- Be willing and able to undergo continuing professional development in regard to their coaching



- Be willing and able to positively influence athletes and other coaching and support staff within the Netball France environment
- Hold a current first aid certificate, or be prepared to obtain one prior to the first in person event

remuneration

This role is a volunteer role, with expenses covered (transport, accommodation, etc.) to be discussed with candidates at the next stage of applications.

Please note in respect of:

- Accommodation: this may in fact be hosting provided by squad members or local clubs.
- Transport: will be reimbursed up to a limit defined as part of the season's budgeting process

In consideration of this role please note that while it is a volunteer role one that is extremely rewarding but also requires significant time commitment in terms of attendance & travel for two-day camps, competition time, athlete & guardian feedback meetings, session planning, venue sourcing & preparation along with other squad administrative duties. In applying for this role Netball France understand that each candidate has evaluated their preparedness for this time commitment.
