Established in 2020, Netball France is the governing body of Netball in France. With an estimated 400–500 players across the country, the sport has seen rapid growth in France since Netball France's inauguration with the launch of a number of events and programs. Our Open National Squad, Les Bleus, have been highly successful since their launch in 2022, with the squad coming 2^{nd} in the second division at the Europe Netball Open Challenge 2023 and placing in 2024, will receive their first world ranking by mid–July. As per Netball France policy, the roles for the Coaching & Management Team are open to applications every 2 years, with current staff eligible to re-apply should they so choose to. The Netball France Open Squad is mixed gender.

LES BLEUS HEAD COACH

The Les Bleus Head Coach will report to the Performance Director and will be responsible for training the Open National Squad, collaborating with the Performance Director, Les Bleus Assistant Coach, and Junior National Squad Coaching Staff to lead on developing the French way of play, aligned with the values and objectives of Netball France.

The Les Bleus Head Coach is expected to lead the Open National Squad Program, under the direction of the Performance Director and with the support of the Les Bleus Assistant Coach. Les Bleus will be training with the goal of competing in the Europe Netball Open Challenge 2025 & 2026 events, as well as NF Mixed events each season. Additional competitions may be considered subject to strategic fit and budget.

key duties

- Oversee end to end selection process for the National Squad and individual competitions,
 - Including provision of appropriate feedback for all athletes regardless of selection status. Using performance calls and Hudl to demonstrate means for improvement for all Squad athletes not selected for competition.
- Development of individual athletes within the National Squad Program training environment
 - Creation & implementation of Performance Analytics process encompassing identification of key metrics of progress, supportive VT clips, and reporting analysis to direct and assist the performance analyst & Assistant coach
 - o Personalisation and deployment of analysis for all athletes post camp and during competition.
 - Conduct three 1-2-1 meetings with all athletes, providing feedback on areas of strength and where to improve.
- Collaborate with fellow coaching staff and athletes to ensure processes and modifications are in place for athletes relating to training schedules, loading, injuries and rehabilitation, and well-being
 - Work in tandem with physios and other therapists to support athletes' full recovery from injury.
- Plan and deliver training camps and at home programs (ball work, shooting, strength & conditioning) for athletes
- Devise and implement Game Plan and strategies effectively for a variety of situations and opponents
- Within the squad develop required skills to deliver Game Plan and strategies successfully
- Liaise with the Performance Director, Les Bleus Assistant Coach, and JNS Coaching Team in relation to national strategy, plans, and integration between the squads
- Input towards High Performance, Operational plans and budgets and contribute to reports as requested
- Organise a NF Mixed Event each season, in conjunction with the Performance Director &
- Build, maintain and retain valuable relationships with affiliated organizations such as Europe Netball, World Netball and other nations in support of the development of the National Squad.
- In preparation for all formal competitions, support the organisation of appropriate friendly competition,
